Vortex Fuel Saver Mandatory Clean Air Filter

Clean Air Filter is Mandatory

It is absolutely mandatory that all vehicles have and maintain a clean air filter when using the **Vortex Fuel Saver** (VFS).

There have been reports that the air filter should be changed after the “stabilization period” (3-4 tanks of fuel). This is an incorrect maintenance schedule.

The filter must be clean when installing the VFS and for that matter, the engine always requires a clean air filter whether a VFS is installed or not.

If the filter is dirty, immediately replace it. A dirty filter does not provide enough air/oxygen for proper combustion and the VFS cannot work. Make sure the filter is clean when installing the VFS and later, if the mileage goes down – it is time to change the filter.

Please notify any user/owner that is testing mileage before and after VFS installation about the clean filter requirement for testing accuracy.
